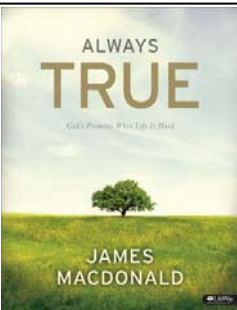

YOUR PASTOR'S HEART

More than 24 million American children live without their biological dads.

It seems this generation has lost its understanding of what great fatherhood looks like. Television and movie dads are often portrayed: weak, perverted, self-centered, or passive. As a result, new fathers in our generation have a devalued sense of purpose, honor, and influence. They often feel unprepared and inadequate in understanding how to be a successful leader for their families.

Joshua, the newly appointed leader of Israel, was replacing Moses and had big shoes to fill. Although Joshua likely felt overwhelmed and afraid, God charged him three times in chapter 1 to "be strong and courageous." In Joshua 24 the prophet called the question for the people and asked for the vote. Yet, regardless of the way the culture swayed or his own people decided to go, Joshua committed his house to serving the Lord (v. 15). He issued a courageous call, took a courageous stand, and set a courageous example for future generations.

Children living without their fathers in the home are more than twice as likely to be poor, to abuse drugs, and to engage in criminal activity than their peers who live with married biological or adoptive parents.

Now it's our turn to "be strong and courageous." God is commanding men today to be leaders in their homes. He is calling men today to lead and to obey Him. He is reminding us all of His presence and power as we shepherd this generation.

The movie, COURAGEOUS, from the creators of the movie, Fireproof, releases in theaters on September 30. In the days ahead you'll see how Chisholm Heights Baptist Church is going to provide an opportunity for our members to use this excellent film as a tool to help encourage the fathers of community to step up to the plate and make a difference in the lives of those whom God has placed under their care. Plan now to be a part of this great ministry event!
